



## Player Photography and Sharing Consent Form

The Albion Park Crows Junior AFL Club are committed to ensuring that the privacy and personal circumstances of each player and their families are respected. Parents and/or legal guardians of each player are required to complete this form at the beginning of each season to ensure the most up-to-date circumstances are captured, noting that consent can be given or withdrawn at any time.

All images will be assessed by the Club for appropriateness prior to posting. This includes but is not limited to posture, positioning and covering of intimate body parts as well as the consent you have provided.

The Club encourages all parents and guardians to consider their personal views and circumstances when completing this form.

Where there are enforceable Court Orders for a player, please ensure the Club has a copy for our records. This form asks you to consider if the publication of an identifiable feature, such as a scar or deformity, may breach a Court Order or place your child at risk, please ensure that you carefully consider your circumstances when answering this question.

If the child is the subject of Family Law Court Orders, please ensure the parent with appropriate legal responsibility has completed this form. In some cases, this might be both parents.
